Shanghai Ocean University, founded in 1912, is a multidisciplinary applied research university.

It is a jointly constructed university by the Shanghai Municipal People's Government, the State Oceanic Administration, and the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs. In September 2017, it was selected into the list of national "World-Class Discipline Construction Universities".





In February 2022, it was selected into the second round of the list of "Double First-Class" construction universities and construction disciplines. The school actively expands foreign cooperation and has close exchanges and cooperation with universities in countries (regions) such as the United States, Japan, South Korea, Germany, Portugal, Australia, Ghana and international organizations such as the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) and the Asian Fisheries Society (AFS).



The university welcomes international students from over 40 countries around the world. There is a strong multicultural atmosphere on campus, allowing students to study and live in an international environment. The language programs, cultural experience activities and a wealth of club activities of the university offer diverse choices for international students.



It has signed cooperation agreements with more than 160 overseas universities and research institutions. The development goal of the school is: by around 2035, its comprehensive strength will enter the forefront of municipal universities, and a high-level characteristic university with significant international influence will be initially built. By around 2050, a high-level characteristic university with significant international influence will be built, and it will enter the ranks of world-class characteristic universities.

- 2. Regardless of whether a student attends class, only 50% of tuition will be refunded if he or she quits school within the first week. No tuition will be refunded from the second week onwards.

CAMPUS ENVIRONMENT

The university is located in Lingang New Area, Pudong New, Shanghai. The campus enjoys beautiful natural scenery and a tranquil environment. The campus architecture incorporates the style of Jiangnan gardens, featuring both traditional and modern characteristics. It is adjacent to Dishui Lake, the largest artificial lake in Asia, providing an ideal place for students to relax and unwind.

STUDENT LIFE AND SUPPORT SERVICES

1. Cultural Activities

Application documents

1. ID Photo.

Personal color photos (full face without hat), head account for 2/3 of photo size; no uniform or white coat; glasses required normally worn; white background, frame-less; clear portrait, rich gradation, and natural expression, without obvious distortion.

2. Passport copy.

A clear copy of your valid passport with name, photo, birth date, place of birth, date of issue, and date of expiry clearly visible.

- 3. Physical examination certificate.
- 4. Certificate of no criminal record.
- 5. Letter of financial guarantee.
- 6. Those who have already studied or worked in China are required to additionally submit the following materials:
- (1) A copy of the residence permit or the page of the visa in China;
- (2) Certificate of enrollment/graduation/ completion of studies or employment certificate.

Applicants aged between 16 and 18 years old are required to additionally submit the following materials:

- (1) Guardian's guarantee letter.
- (2) Other relevant entrusted certification materials.

(3) Cash payment. International students can pay relevant fees as a single cash payment, RMB is the only currency accepted.

After receiving the online application form, all relevant documents and application fees, SHOU will respond within 10 working days.

VISA APPLICATION

Students accepted by SHOU will receive an Admission Package containing an Admission Notice, Visa Application Form for Study in China (JW202), New Students Guide, as well as the Semester Calendar and Campus Map. With these documents students must apply for a Chinese visa at their local Chinese embassy or consulate.

PICK-UP SERVICE

On designated days prior to registration week, SHOU provides pick-up service from Terminals 1 and 2 at Shanghai Pudong International Airport. Students who needs pick-up service are required to submit an official application at your personal SHOU account.
